By-Laws

- Proposed By-Law changes were emailed to the members in advance of the meeting
- A question was asked if the new proposed By-Law Article VI Allocation of Funds, "Reserves should be used to manage budget shortfalls and excesses. Reserves could also be used for unbudgeted expenditures or donations" is over and above the discretionary line of \$1,000 in the proposed budget?
- A second question was asked, does the By-Law Article VI Allocation of Funds, "The President has Executive privilege to extend a \$100 expenditure without Board or

member approval. Should a larger amount up to \$500 be needed, the Executive Board would be contacted by telephone or e-mail for their vote. Unbudgeted expenditures over \$500 require Membership approval" apply to both the By-law Reserves and the discretionary line in the proposed budget?

- Kathy Morris stated that the Reserves are under the guidelines of the \$100 and \$500 limits and any amount spent above that would have to be voted on by the membership
- Joan Brown recommended that the following sentence in the proposed article VI By-Laws "Reserves could also be used for unbudgeted expenditures or donations" be deleted.
- Joan Brown made a motion to table the voting on the By-Laws and send the By-Laws back to the committee. Susan Walker seconded the motion. This motion was voted on and approved.

Budget

- The Final Budget Proposal for the 2017-2018 WC calendar year was presented by Mary Sacavage
- Motion was made by Jane Campbell to accept the proposed budget and was seconded by Kathy Knittel. The motion was voted on and approved.
