Questions can be referred to Jeanne Rosol and Rita Foster.

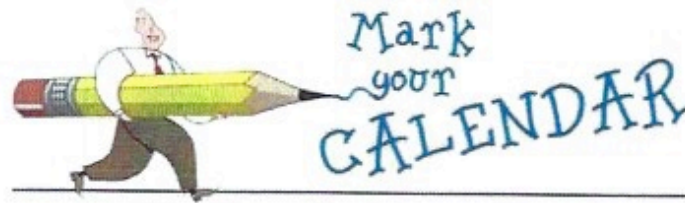
Debbie deferred to Jan Frieden, who requested the members to donate \$10 to the kitchen cupboard committee for the Arts and Crafts Festival if
